The Game face of a Mighty Man; Tenacity of Soul, The Gritting of the teeth of the Spirit-inspired warrior, and the bearing of those teeth to the enemy, Chazaq is possessing a Resolute and Growling Resolve for the Glory of God; a Flush of Spiritual Fervor; a tensing of all a soldier's muscle.
